"They have certainly disbelieved who say, 'Allah is the Messiah, the son of Mary' while the Messiah has said, 'O Children of Israel, worship Allah, my Lord and your Lord.' Indeed, he who associates others with Allah - Allah has forbidden him Paradise, and his refuge is the Fire. And there are not for the wrongdoers any helpers."

"They have certainly disbelieved who say, 'Allah is the third of three.' And there is no god except one God. And if they do not desist from what they are saying, there will surely afflict the disbelievers among them a painful punishment."

These dynamic statements demonstrate that the Quran stands as a divine **Criterion** (Al-Furqan). It cuts through centuries of theological drift to remind humanity that Jesus was a noble prophet of God, not God incarnate. "Indeed, they who disbelieved among the People of the Scripture and the polytheists will be in the fire of Hell, abiding eternally therein. Those are the worst of creatures."

2. Similitude in Rulings: Unity of Source vs. Plagiarism

The Synthesis of Muhammad ﷺ	The perfect balance. It permanently secures systemic justice while explicitly opening the door to spiritual excellence and forgiveness.

Look at how beautifully balanced the final message is. God Almighty says in the Quran:

وَجَزَاءُ سَيِّئَةٍ سَيِّئَةٌ مِّثْلُهَا ۚ فَمَنْ عَفَا وَأَصْلَحَ فَأَجْرُهُ عَلَى اللَّهِ ۖ

"And the retribution for an evil act is an evil one like it, but whoever pardons and makes reconciliation - his reward is from Allah."

Islam established a robust legal system founded on just accountability—capable of building civilizations, organizing states, and protecting nations—while seamlessly weaving in moral excellence. This comprehensive legal framework was completely absent from the earlier purely localized moral preaching.
